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Notes for Editors

1. Greenscents products are certified by The Soil Association, The Vegan Society, Cruelty-Free International, Allergy UK & I'm Green. Greenscents is also an Ethical Consumer Best Buy, coming top in all relevant categories.
2. Greenscents products are made to order in small batches in Somerset, UK.
3. Unlike most eco-products, all Greenscents products are certified organic and list all ingredients on the bottle in language people can understand.
4. Greenscents products are highly concentrated, which contributes to a lower carbon footprint in terms of production and shipping as well as use by the consumer. When purchased in 5 litre or 20 litre refills, this footprint reduces even more.
5. Greenscents standard and mini bottles are made of recyclable and sustainable biopolymer made from the waste from sugar cane production. These can be refilled by purchasing 5 litre bag in a box containers – the outer cardboard packaging can be put into paper waste for recycling and the inner plastic container can be returned to Greenscents to make sure that it is recycled. The 20 litre containers are plastic jerrycans which can be returned to Greenscents for cleaning with organic cider vinegar and re-use up to 20 times. To date there is no non-plastic alternative for this size of container.
